

I have run a Human Rights Awareness Campaign at grass root level among five upozila of Gaibandha districts from 21st November to 28 November 2019. I could able to facilitate more than 16 sessions and reached more than five hundred people who were from different communities, religions and different professions. I also reached to students of high school and college students to make them more aware about Human Rights. But the majority people were indigenous people . I took sessions on the universal declaration of Human Rights, how the the human rights violate and what to be done. Moreover, Gender equality was also focused during my sessions. During the campaign, I tried to make sure the presence of woman, man and child participant. However, some noticeable changes I noticed before and after the sessions. A poor number of people heard the words "Human Rights". After the sessions, they responded very well which was remarkable breakthrough of this program that made me really happy. I have a strong network with those rural people now. I also listened their challenges, they are facing in their areas. On 10 December, I reflected those to the Chairman of National Human Rights Commission, Member of Parliament, Human rights activists, Professors from different universities, a secretary of Home ministry and other govt. and non govt organisation.
